Bidder may check on their own whether they are covered under the exemption provision. Not Acceptable. Tender condition shall prevail.

In this regard, please be informed that PBG is issued by bank after securing 100% deposit of the PBG amount from their customer. Therefore, the 10% amount shall be blocked by the bank and notwithstanding same if retention money is debited from the Bidder's RA Bill, then the same would be an additional financial burden on the Bidder. Mobilization Fees: - In pursuance to Clause No. 3.26 of Section 3 General Conditions of Contract, 75% of the amount to be paid as mobilization charges on completion of total mobilization of the dredgers and other ancillary equipment and upon completion of at least 5% of the total dredging quantity. We hereby request you to kindly amend the clause as, 75% of the amount to be paid as mobilization charges on completion of mobilization at site, as deployment of the requisite dredgers and other ancillary equipment are very capital intensive and amendment of the same would help us in maintaining a positive cash flow. 5. Requirement of TSHD in Kandla Creek – We would like to bring your kind attention to Clause No. 6.4.1 General of Section – 6, Specification of Dredging Work wherein in pursuance to the 3rd Last Paragraph, "To carry out the dredging operations suitable Trailer Suction Hopper Dredger (TSHD) / Cutter Suction Dredger (CSD) / Backhoe dredger (BHD) / Grab dredger need to be deployed to dredge area of Kandla Creek." However, in pursuance to Clause no. f of Brief Description of Project, "The Trailing Suction Hopper Dredgers deployed at Kandla creek should be capable of dredging to a depth upto 20 m." In this regard, kindly clarify in case it is necessary to deploy TSHD in order to conduct dredging works at Kandla Creek, as deployment of TSHD shall enable the Bidders for completion of the subject dredging works within the stipulated timeframe.
