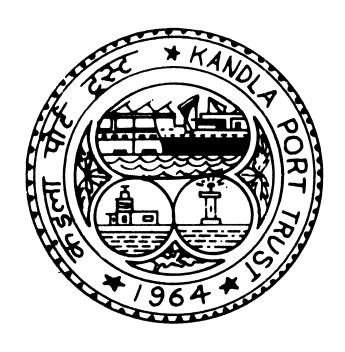

## Section 1: Vision, Mission, Objectives and Functions

#### Vision:

To be the one of the most economical Modern Ports rendering cost effective services to our customers.

#### Mission:

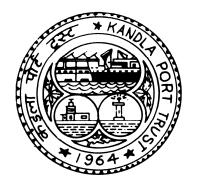
Kandla Port will emerge as a vibrant, world class, multi-cargo port offering services at multiple locations and having a dominant share of regional cargo by virtue of its ability to effectively leverage its locations and land resources for facilitation of growth of economic activities and investments, with the objective of developing mutually beneficial and sustainable linkages with port based industries and users, thereby making Kandla the driver of economic growth in the region.

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## PART - I

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

#### KANDLA PORT - OVERVIEW

The History of the Major Port of Kandla goes back to 1930, when H.E. Khengarji III, the Maharaja of Kutch built a RCC jetty at Old Kandla. Ships with draught up to 8 metres could berth in the said jetty throughout the year. This Jetty became the nucleus of what in later years was to emerge as the Kandla Port.

The Kandla Port would not have gained the prominence it enjoys now, but for the intervention of history in the form of the country's post independence partition into two Nations, INDIA and PAKISTAN. Due to the partition, the Port of Karachi went to Pakistan and therefore, the whole of North – West India was without an outlet to sea and the vast hinterland comprising about one lakh Sq. Kms in the north-western region of the nation needed an alternate arrangement. The consequent diversion of traffic to the Bombay and Kolkata Ports was not only inconvenient and uneconomical to the Trade owing to the distance involved, it also severely strained the limited resources of these Ports. In order to remedy this situation, the Union Government set up a committee called the "West Coast Major Port Development Committee" in the year 1948.

The Committee chose Kandla because of the distinct advantage of its dry climate. The region experiences a scanty monsoon and as a result, there is hardly any loss of working days and thus, the chances of damage to cargo are considerably reduced.

In the year 1950, the Union Government formally took over the minor Port of Kandla for its development as a Major Port of India. The Foundation for the New Major Port of Kandla was laid by the Late Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the then Prime Minister of India, on January 10, 1952. The Kandla was declared a Major Port of India on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 1955 by the then Transport Minister, late Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri. The old Jetty built by the Kutch Maharaja was converted into an Oil Jetty.

The first two Cargo Berths constructed were dedicated to the service of the nation on March 3, 1957. Later in the same year, two more berths were thrown open to sea traffic. 1964 was the next Landmark year for Kandla. The Government of India declared it as Kandla Port Trust, an Autonomous Body constituted under the Major Port Trusts Act, 1963 on 29<sup>th</sup> February, 1964.

The history of the Port would be incomplete without a mention of the Off-Shore Oil Terminal at Vadinar situated in the Jamnagar District, which is about 300 Kms from Kandla by road and 50 Nautical miles by sea.

A decision was taken to develop an Oil Terminal where Very Large Crude Oil vessels could be handled, from where the crude oil is pumped to Koyali Refinery through pipeline. While the pipeline project was with the IOCL, the Ministry of Shipping entrusted the task of developing the infrastructure and Port facilities to the Kandla Port, which swung into action and set up a full fledged department under the charge of a Superintending Engineer in 1974. On approval of the project report and funds, the creation of the handling facilities was started. The Terminal was commissioned on 27<sup>th</sup> August, 1978 well before the target date and the first vessel MT Subhash Chandra Bose, carrying 87,000 tones of Crude oil, was brought at the Single Buoy Mooring of the Off-Shore Oil Terminal.

The Port was growing steadily and to keep pace with the growing demands of the trade, it continued with the infrastructure development of the Port by adding five more cargo berths and three more oil berths during the period from 1990 to 2006, besides creation of storage facilities, both open and covered. The Kandla Port which handled 8.44 lakh tones in 1957-58 has seen record handling of 33.73 MMT in 1996-97, 38.90 MMT in 1997-98, 40.64 MMT in 1998-99 and 46.30 MMT in 1999-2000, which was the highest amongst the Major Ports of India and thus, performed a Hattrick by standing first amongst the Ports in Cargo Handling. The Port handled 92.50 MMT during the year under report.

The Kandla Port Trust commenced the Containerized cargo handling in October, 1981. While the Port handled 1217 TEUs in 1982-83 , the figure went up to 1,77,600 TEUs in 2006-07, weighing 27.75 lakh tones. The Port has 12 dry cargo berths and 6 oil berths as on date. 2254 ships called on the Port in the fiscal 2014-15 as against 2299 in 2013-14. The Port handled 92.50 MMT of cargo and thereby, retaining the number one position for volume of cargo handled among the Major Ports of India during the year 2014-15.

The Kandla Port, which started functioning in a house near Jubilee Ground, Bhuj, about 70 Kms from the present port as a small office headed by an officer appointed by the Govt. of India as the first Development Commissioner, has emerged as the Port of Millennium over the last 63 years rendering professional, cost effective and value added services to its customers. The hinterland of the Kandla Port consists of States of Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Rajasthan, Delhi, Gujarat and parts of Madhya Pradesh, Uttaranchal and Uttar Pradesh. The Port, a protected harbour, is situated in the Kandla creek, 90 Kms from the mouth of Gulf of Kutch.

Kandla is a multi-product port. It has 12 dry cargo berths with a total length of 2.57 K.M. in a straight line and 6 oil berths for handling of POL and chemical. Three Single Buoy Moorings in Vadinar can handle Very Large Crude Oil vessels (VLCC) with a maximum pumping capacity of 10000 tonnes per hour.

#### **MANAGEMENT OF THE PORT**

The Port is an Autonomous Body constituted by the Government of India under the MPT Act, 1963. At the top of the organization, there is a Board of Trustees, consisting of the Chairman, Deputy Chairman and 17 other members, representing Central Government, State Government, Railways, Customs, Coast Guard, Trade & Commerce, Mercantile Marine Deptt., Associations, representing Port-users, Labour employed in the Port & other Interests, etc., as may be appointed by the GOI from time to time.

#### **ORGANISATIONAL SET UP:-**

The Kandla Port Trust is having nine departments viz., General Administration, Finance, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Medical, Traffic, Vigilance, Marine at Kandla and Off-shore Oil Terminal at Vadinar and the operational departments are providing various services to the Port-users, including infrastructural facilities. Shri Ravi Parmar, IAS, was the Chairman (I/c) of the Port during the year under report.

Utmost customer satisfaction through quick, efficient and qualitative services, has been the foremost objective. The Port's major thrust has been on replacement and modernization of existing productive assets, in order to maximize operational efficiency and to ensure sustained growth in cargo handling capacity, to cater to the ever increasing expectations of customers.

The Kandla Port is an ISO 9001: 2008 & ISO 14001:2004 certified and ISPS compliant Port.

- Medical treatment to retired Port employees.

### CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CSR) PROJECT AT KANDLA PORT TRUST

The Kandla Port Trust had started Corporate Social Responsibility scheme from the year 2011 as per the CSR Guidelines. The Board had approved Rs. 3.00 Crore during the year 2011-2012 and Rs. 4.00 Crore during the year 2012-13 for the Corporate Social Responsibility Scheme.

The Board had approved the certain CSR activities / works and accordingly, the Kandla Port Trust has spent about Rs. 5.64 Crore for the completion of said CSR activities / works.

Further, the Board had approved the amount Rs. 6.43 Crore during the year 2013-14 and Rs. 1.07 Crore during the year 2014-15 for the CSR Scheme at Kandla Port Trust.

#### **MEDICAL FACILITIES**

The Port Trust maintains Hospitals for Kandla Port Trust employees at Gopalpuri, New Kandla, Health Centre at Vadinar and dispensary at Adipur. Medical cover is provided for Port employees and their dependants as well as dock workers/employees and their dependants. Apart from the above, free medical facilities are also provided to C.I.S.F. personnel and their dependent family members at this Port Hospitals/dispensary. The employees and dependants of Central Government Department and Public Undertakings also avail the medical benefits on payment basis. The retired Port employees and their spouses are also availing out-door as well as in-door medical treatment at the Port hospitals as per the Kandla Port Retired Employees (Medical benefit) Scheme, 2009. Reimbursements are being made as per the C.G.H.S. rates.

#### **FACILITIES AVAILABLE**

The best possible medical facilities are provided to the employees in both hospitals, which are well equipped with modern facilities. Doctors in almost all branches of modern medicine like Obstetric and Gynecology, General Surgery, General medicine, Ophthalmology, Anesthesiology, ENT, Pediatrics, Orthopedics, Dermatology, Radiology, Dentistry, Psychiatry, Ayurvedic and Homeopathy system on regular basis as well as on part-time visiting basis are available.

Presently, a team of 10 Medical Officer, one RMO and 11 Part-Time visiting consultants are rendering general and specialist treatment at both Gopalpuri and Kandla Hospital.

The Port Hospitals are equipped with operation theatres, which is fully Airconditioned with modern facilities where major surgical procedures relating to obstetric and gynecology, general surgery, ENT and Orthopedic are performed. Ophthalmology operations are performed by our Part-time Ophthalmologist in a separate Operation Theatre provided at Gopalpuri Hospital. During the year under report, 211 operations were performed. When Super-specialty or extra high-tech facilities are required, cases are referred to 23 numbers of recognized hospitals, over and above Government Hospitals, within the State.

A Physiotherapy unit is attached to the main hospital at Gopalpuri with qualified Part-time Physiotherapist for providing physiotherapy exercises to orthopedic cases, including physically handicapped patients due to polio myelities, accidents etc.

As a step ahead, number of hospitals are recognized for specialized treatment to KPT and CISF employees/workers and their dependent family members as well as K.P.T. retired employees and their spouses. Further, empanelment of Private Doctors in various specialties for gainfully utilizing their services for the benefit of Port employees in emergent situations/difficult or critical surgical operations (General/Obstetrics & Gynecology/ENT etc.) are also available.

Besides, Credit facilities/direct billing (for in-service regular employees) has also been introduced under which the payment towards treatment of employees is directly billed to the KPT and patient need not require to make any payment to the hospitals.

At present, almost all types of medical facilities are provided at the port hospitals at Gopalpuri and New Kandla. There are two X-Ray Units one each at Gopalpuri and New Kandla, where all type of X-Rays are taken. An Ultra sound machine also purchased and as such Sonography of obstetrics & Gyneac, medical and surgical nature is also carried out. There are also two fully equipped clinical laboratories one at Gopalpuri and other at New Kandla Hospitals where all types of bio-chemical investigations are carried out.

At Gopalpuri Hospital, 4068 X-Rays consisting of routine X-Rays, 1 No. I.V. Pyelography 63 Nos. Sonography were done at Gopalpuri Hospital. While at New Kandla Hospital, 565 X-Rays of routine nature were taken during the year 2014-15. So far as Laboratory Tests at Gopalpuri Hospital are concerned, there were 14733 various tests were carried out. During the year under report, 75654 outdoor patients visited Gopalpuri Hospital. At New Kandla Hospital and Adipur Dispensary, 8356 & 4913 numbers of patients respectively visited as outdoor patients. At Gopalpuri and Kandla Hospitals, 1624 & 156 numbers of patients respectively were admitted as Indoor Patients.

At the Off-shore Oil Terminal, Vadinar, one dispensary-cum-health centre is functioning with two medical officers. The Health Centre consists of modern X-Ray unit, clinical laboratory facilities, qualified nursing personnel and other paramedical staff. Besides, visiting specialists are engaged in almost all branches of medicine at the centre for the benefit of employees and their dependants there.

Free Ambulance service is provided to the Port employees in case of emergency within a radius of 08 KMs to reach hospital and to shift serious cases to outstation hospital within the State when referred to by the competent medical authority of the Port Trust.

Apart from the routine curative treatment, KPT focuses on the following areas:-

- 1. Hospital Waste Disposal Management
- 2. Pre-placement & periodical examination of all employees
- 3. AIDS awareness with Co-ordination of private organizations, PSI.
- 4. Pulse Polio Programme.
- 5. Disaster preparedness and Management.
- 6. Health Education Programme and Counseling.

#### **PORT SECURITY**

The Security of the Port is entrusted to the CISF, which has a strength of 447 personnel under the control of Sr. Commandant, CISF.

#### **HOUSING**

Residential quarters for officers/staff are maintained at three places viz., Gopalpuri, Kandla and Vadinar. There are 785 Quarters of different types in Gopalpuri, 864 at Kandla and 428 quarters at Vadinar. Apart from this, adequate number of quarters are available in the workers' colony for allotment to the Cargo Handling Workers.

#### **DREDGING**

Due to siltation in the Channel, maintenance dredging is essential in the Port to achieve the draught for shipping operations. Dredging was executed through the DCI on tender basis. During the year, an expenditure of Rs.295.01 crores was incurred towards capital dredging and average maintenance dredging in the port, thereby, maintaining a depth of 8.63 metres below chart Datum:-

#### **EDUCATION**

The medical check-up was conducted by **State government Primary Health Centre** from 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2014. Children were examined, especially by eye specialist, and 10 students of class 10<sup>th</sup> were provided with free spectacles for weak eyesight.

- Special awards were given by the Sr. DSG of KPT to the students of BVM Kandla for participating in the celebrations of Vigilance Awareness Week – 2014.

This year, 60 S.S.C forms were submitted online.

#### **IMPLEMENTATION OF RAJBHASHA:-**

To accelerate the pace of Rajbhasha Hindi in Port Trust, Hindi Cell is functioning in the Port, which consists of three Hindi Translators, one Hindi Typist. It undertakes the translation work of Circulars, Notices, Administration, Accounts, Audit Reports, Board Resolutions, Notifications, Code Manuals, Statutory literature, various forms and registers, etc. It looks after the general correspondence with the Ministry of Shipping and the Department of Official Language, Ministry of Home Affairs and arrange Hindi Fortnight annually. Review of Progressive use of Hindi in the monthly meetings of all Departments of the Port Trust and to suggest measures to be taken for enhancement of Rajbhasha. It collects information and prepares Agenda and Minutes for Quarterly Meetings of Official Language Implementation Committee and half yearly meetings of Town Official Language Implementation Committee, Gandhidham-Kandla, presided over by the Chairman. HODs of Central Government Offices, Undertakings, Banks and Oil Companies located in Gandhidham-Kandla Complex are the members of TOLIC Committee. Hindi Cell also prepares, procure and supply helpful literature to the staff and strive hard for promotion of Hindi as Official Language in the Port Trust. It also ensures the Implementation of decisions taken at the meetings of Official Language Committee of the Port Trust.

#### **ACHIEVEMENTS OF VIGILANCE DEPARTMENT**

The Vigilance Department of Kandla Port Trust, headed by the Chief Vigilance Officer, has been engaging itself in various Preventive, Proactive, Participative and Punitive Vigilance to meet the standard norms set by the Govt. of India and various watch dogs Agencies like CVC, etc. In addition, the Vigilance Department has also taken various initiatives to ensure fairness and accountability in all operations of Kandla Port Trust. The efforts of the Vigilance Department have also resulted into recoveries and savings. The highlights of the achievements of the Vigilance Department are given below:-

#### **PREVENTIVE VIGILANCE**

- (i) Based on the inspection conducted at Off-shore Oil Terminal Department, Vadinar, in December, 2014, an investigation into payment of exorbitant overtime allowance was initiated. As a result, financial outflow of Rs.16 lakh per month has been reduced. This is a recurring savings for KPT to the extent of Rs. 1.92 Crores p.a. in respect of OOT, Vadinar, alone.
- (ii) Online submission of Annual Property Returns was implemented during Vigilance Awareness Week -2014 and Training thereon for Officers was also organized.
- (iii) **"e-Vigilance Manual"** was published by the Vigilance Department, KPT.
- (iv) The Vigilance Department has brought out an e-Newsletter titled as "e-VigDarpan" covering various activities undertaken during the Vigilance Awareness week 2014 and the same was uploaded on KPT web-site under Vigilance Corner.
- (v) Sensitive posts identified and notified through a Circular.
- (vi) Pointed out to Finance Department about the Monthly PF contribution of certain employees in KPT exceeding their salary. In response, Finance Department issued a Circular, directing all Drawing Officers to ensure that PF subscription of any employee working under them shall not be more than his/her emoluments, as prescribed in Regulation 8(2) of the KPE (GPF) Regulations, 1964.
- (vii) Violation of provisions of availing Compensatory Off noticed and circular issued to all HODs for corrective action.
- (viii) Agreed List, 2015 has been prepared and finalized in consultation with CBI.

#### **PUNITIVE VIGILANCE**

(a) Regular Departmental Action (RDA): Out of 53 nos. of Disciplinary Proceedings in respect of major penalties, 28 cases have been disposed of. Likewise, out of 28 nos. of proceedings in respect of minor penalties, 26 cases have been disposed of.

#### **INITIATIVE/SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT**

- (a) Initiated action for revival of Hospital Management System with the proposal to link family photos of the employees.
- (b) Initiated action for revival of the File Tracking System which was not being used.
- (c) Initiated action on weeding out of Records and proposal sent to the Management for reviewing and formulating a Weeding out policy.
- (d) A report on "Swachh Bharat Mission" covering the areas/series of events already carried out by Vigilance such as,(a) Scheme for clean KPT Colony with Vigilance Trees, (b) Entry of animals in port area/Animals inside the port area, (c) Unhygienic conditions in port area, (d) Indiscipline Truck Movement/Disciplined Traffic inside the port area, (e) Maintaining cleanliness in Office, (f) Weeding out of old records.
- (e) A special drive of inspection was undertaken by the Vigilance Department by forming a team of Officials, including officials from other Departments.
- (f) There was a free access to outsiders/visitors in the offices of KPT. The matter was taken up with the Administration for monitoring the entry and exit of the outsiders/visitors, including KPT vehicles and employees vehicles, for taking action from the security point of view.
- (g) Based on Vigilance recommendation, Chairman appointed a Committee of HODs to look into the issue relating to underutilization of Kandla Hospital in consultation with Labour Trustees.
- (h) In a Vigilance Communication Meeting (VCM) during the period with HODs and the officials of Finance Department, issues relating to excess payment made to certain senior Officers, Compensatory off for a longer period, huge variation between estimate and tender cost in few contracts, delay in processing and making of payments in certain cases, piecemeal queries by Finance causing abnormal delay, abnormal high OTA without justification, receipt of revenue accepted without contract/agreement papers, non-reconciliation of cash in hand, preparation of manuals by Departments, etc., were pointed out for corrective action.
- (i) As a part of simplification of procedure and practices, recommendations made relating to payment of medical reimbursement.

(j) In the Hospital Management System, some data base correction and linking with the family photos of the employees was implemented w.e.f. 01.01.2015 and the File Tracking System was also proposed to be adopted from January, 2015. Concerned HODs have been asked to implement the same.

#### **TRAINING & AWARENESS PROGRAMMES:**

- (a) A one day Vigilance Sensitization programme was organized by the Vigilance Department on "Vigilance Administration and Annual Property Returns" and 27 Officials participated in the said training programme. This was the third Batch, sensitized on this module developed to cover all Officers of KPT.
- (b) An Interactive Session with Shri R. Ramakrishnan, IAS, CVO, VOC Port Trust, was organized for the officials of KPT on 30.07.2014 as a part of the Vigilance Sensitization Series.

#### **ASSISTANCE PROVIDED TO EXTERNAL AGENCIES**

In addition to the above, assistance was also provided by the officials of Vigilance Department to the CVC and other organizations for some international projects during Golden Jubilee Celebration of CVC and faculty assistance to the various Public Sector Organizations in the matter relating to Vigilance.

#### **AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS DURING THE YEAR 2014-15**

The last fiscal has also been the year of awards and recognition for the excellent performance of the Port in all fields. The awards which Kandla Port has received during the last year are as follows:

- Awarded "the Major Port of the year 2014 Award" in the 2<sup>nd</sup> edition of Coastal Shipping and Inland Water Transport Business summit concurrent organized by India Sea Trade Award- 2014.
- Kandla Port Trust awarded with the Quality Mark Award 2014 Kandla Port Trust (KPT) has emerged as a prominent winner at the Quality Mark Award 2014 this year, organized by Quality Mark Trust.
- Awarded "best Major Port of the year 2014" in CEO Roundtable Concurrent with Awards on 7<sup>th</sup> February during Gujarat Junction -2015 organized by EXIM Multimedia (India) Pvt. Ltd.

# PART-III ANNUAL ACCOUNTS

The Annual Accounts of the Kandla Port Trust for the year 2014-15 have been drawn up in the prescribed formats as required under section 102 (1) of the Major Port Trust Act 1963. Accordingly, the Annual Accounts are prepared and attached herewith.

The salient features of the financial performance are as under:

#### 1. <u>Traffic</u>

The year 2014-15 recorded increase of 6.31% in traffic. The Port has handled 924.97 lakh tonnes of cargo during 2014-15 as against 870.05 lakh tonnes in 2013-14. The traffic at Kandla and Vadinar is tabulated below:

#### **REMUNERATIVE SERVICES**

#### 1) WAREHOUSING:

This activity is remunerative. There is surplus of Rs. 25.21 crores as against last year's surplus of Rs. 18.68 crores. This is mainly due to increase in operating income by Rs. 7.10 crores and increase in total cost by Rs.0.57 crores only.

#### 2) POL HANDLING AT OIL JETTY:

This activity is remunerative this time with surplus of Rs. 2.83 crores as against surplus of Rs. 8.28 crores of last year.. There is decrease in surplus by Rs. 5.45 crores, mainly due to increase in total cost by Rs. 6.25 crores which is off set by increase in operating income by Rs. 0.80 crores.

#### **UN-REMUNERATIVE SERVICES**

#### 1) **GENERAL CARGO HANDLING:**

The General Cargo Handling activity is unremunerative with a deficit of Rs.184.86 crores as compared to deficit of Rs. 130.54 crores last year. Total cost is increased by Rs. 61.08 crores. While operating income is increased by Rs.6.75 crores due to increase in traffic by 6.31%. The deficit has increased during current year due to pending revision of wharfage rates which is due for revision w.e.f. 1.4.2013.

#### 2) PORT SERVICES:

The activity is unremunerative with deficit of Rs.158.35 crores during this year compared to deficit of Rs.187.85 crores of previous year. The decrease in deficit by Rs. 29.5 crores is mainly due to decrease in Total Cost by Rs.23.15 crores on account of backlog dredging carried out during previous year. The Operating Income is increased by Rs. 6.34 crores mainly due to increase in GRT by 36 lakh tonnes during current year. The deficit under this activity is also required to be made good by suitable revision of rates.

## 3) PILOTAGE:

This activity with the total income of Rs. 137.48 crores and total cost of Rs. 209.83 crores is also unremunerative. There is increase in cost by Rs. 44.36 crores whereas total income has marginally increased by Rs. 0.99 crores, which is mainly due to pending revision of pilotages charges.

#### 4) **BERTHING & MOORING:**

Berthing & mooring activity is unremunerative this year with deficit of Rs. 43.40 crores , as against deficit of Rs. 18.46 crore last year. There is decrease in Operating Income by Rs. 0.73 crores due to decrease in No. of vessel from 2304 t o 2216. While total cost is increased by Rs. 24.22 crores .

#### 5) WATER SUPPLY:

This activity is unremunerative this time with deficit of Rs. 3.03 crore, which is mainly due to decrease in income by Rs. 9.07 crore during the current year.

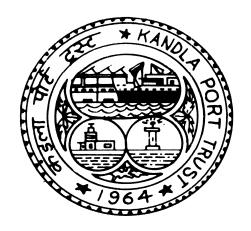

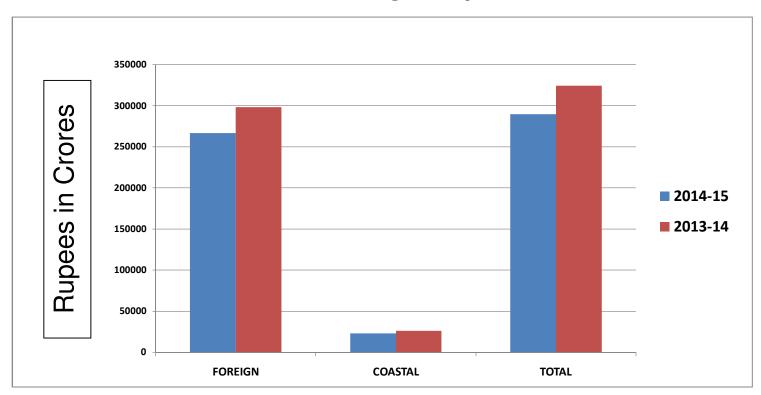

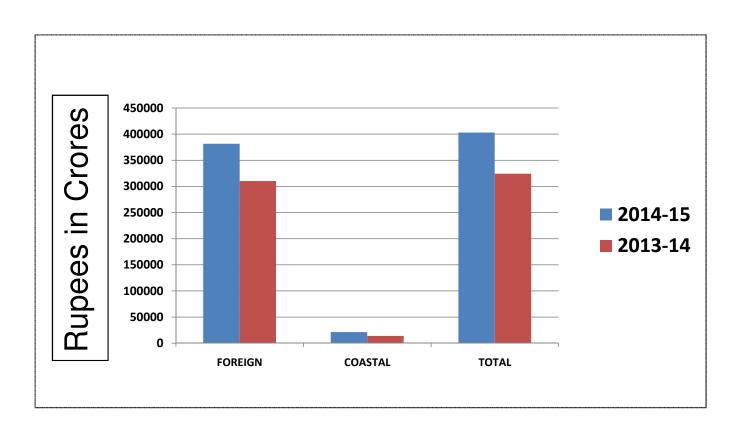

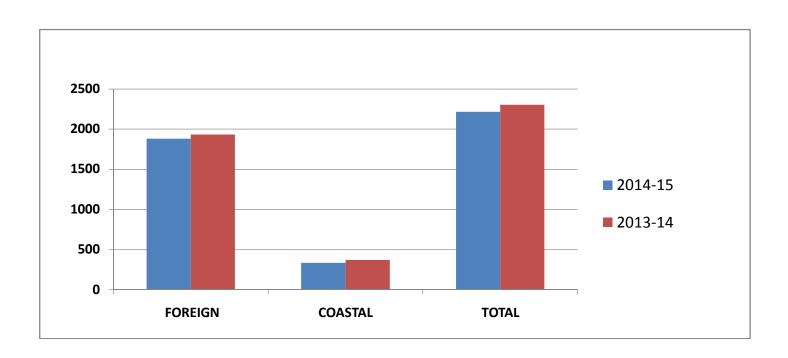
## **Value of Cargo (Exports)**



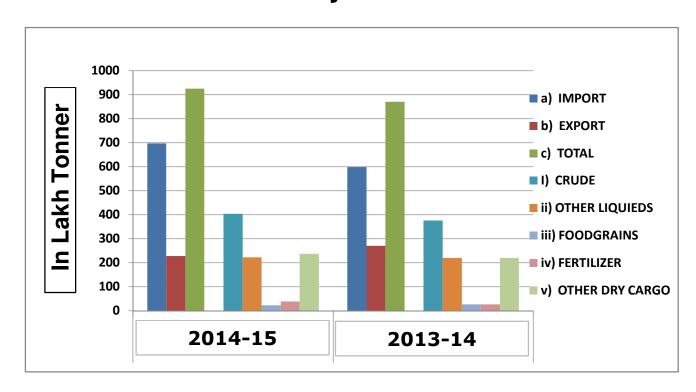
# **Value of Cargo (Imports)**



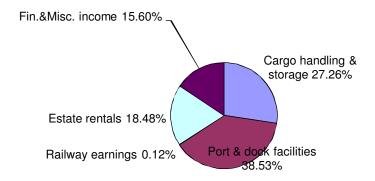
## **Number of Vessels Handled**



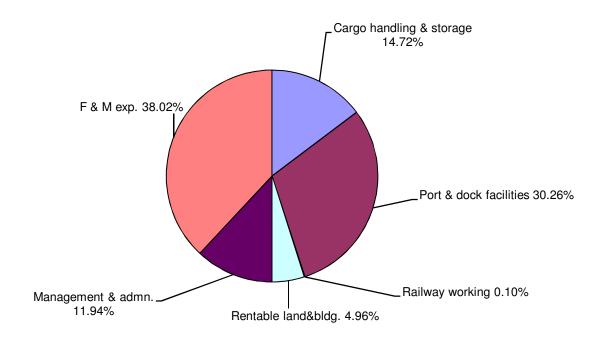
# **Commodity Wise Traffic**

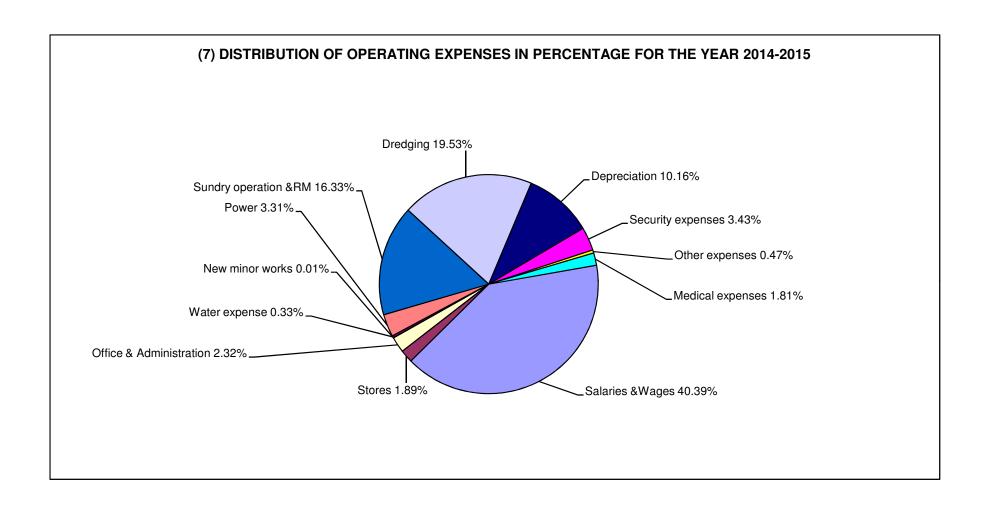


#### (5) INCOME IN PERCENTAGE FOR THE YEAR 2014-15
