

Terms & Conditions

1	The work is to be carried out inside cargo jetty area, Kandla.
2	The work shall be completed within 180 days after issue of work order or clear site of work is given.
3	The quotationer are expected to have full knowledge of the site of work & local working condition before submitting the quotation.
4	The quotationer shall be required to execute the work in such a way so as not to cause any damage / hindrance with the activity going on in near by area.
5	All the rules & regulation governing D.P.A. will be applicable.
6	Whenever & whichever machineries, tools or equipments are to be arranged by quotationers along with fuel charges.
7	PAN number & GST registration No. shall have to furnish by Quotationer, failing which the Bid / Quotation will be considered as non – respective and be liable for discharge.
8	After completion of work the site should be neatly cleaned by the Quotationer.
9	Force majeure : This will be restricted to natural calamities and acts of GOD only.
10	All the material shall required for the work shall be got approved from engineer in charge before put into use.
11	1st and Final bill shall be paid after satisfactory completion of work.
12	Quotation fee of Rs. 590/- (Inclusive of GST) & EMD of Rs. 4,955/- shall be submitted in form of Digital mode of payment at Bank of Baroda, Gandhidham Branch, Account No. 10080100022427, IFSC code: - BARBOGANKUT.
13	Superintending Engineer (PL) reserves the right to cancel the quotation without assigning any reasons and also increase/ decrease the quantum of work.
14	If the contractor failed to provide tanker as per directives of Engineer-in-charge for any day, the penalty will be recovered two times of quoted rates per day for each day of failure.
15	Payment will be made by RTGS only after satisfactory completion of work and submission of duly signed bill.
16	The contractor shall not deposit any materials at such a place,that may cause inconvenience to the public or staff or near by offices.
17	For the purpose of measurement the method prescribed in standard code of measurement of the concern work shall be applicable.
18	All tools, plants, scaffolding ladder etc and other machinery etc. required temporary for the purpose of execution of work will have to be arranged by the contractor at his own cost and storing of such tools, plants etc will have to be made by him.
19	The contractor shall affix SEAL along with SIGNATURE in the quotation,failing which the bid/Quotation will be consider as non-responsive and liable to discharge.
20	The Contractor shall ensure not to cause any damage to the port properties in the vicinity of work site during execution of work. If any damage occurs due to workmen / machinery of the contractor, the contractor has to make good the loss / damage at his cost.

21	<p>(A) GST Clause: The bidder shall quote the price exclusive of GST. The bidder shall quote prevailing GST rate separately, which shall be reimbursed by DPA after ascertaining necessary compliance as per Goods & Service Tax, 2017. All other duties, taxes, cesses applicable if any, shall be borne by the contractor.</p> <p>(B) Deduction of Income-Tax: Income-Tax deductions and surcharge as applicable thereon shall be made good while making payments due to the contractor for carrying out the work and only net amount shall be paid as directed by the Central Board of Direct Taxes, Ministry of Finance, Government of India.</p> <p>(C) TDS of GST The TDS under GST Act is required to be deducted @ 2% (1% CGST & 1% SGST or 2% IGST) from payment / credit given to contractors/professional & others, for work order/contract exceeding Rs. 250000/-</p>												
22	All the rules and regulations in force for entry inside Oil Jetty are shall be followed by the quotationer. He should take entry pass for him and workers from Commandant of CISF directly.												
23	EMD of the bidder other than L-1 & L-2 will be released within seven days from date of opening of quotation.												
24	<p>In case of Micro and Small Enterprise (MSEs) holding valid certificate issued by any agencies/organization under The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises indicating the sub-class list of activity related to the subject tender as per National Industrial Classification-2008 mentioned in the table below only shall become eligible for exemption from payment of Quotation fee/EMD. Such bidder shall upload in preliminary bid a scanned copy of valid certificate as well as duly filled and signed "Bid Security Declaration" as per format provided with this quotation failing which the bid shall be considered as non-responsive.
