
The project is yet to be awarded. DPA is exploring the possibility of identifying the captive user for the project. No activity has been initiated to date on the project site.



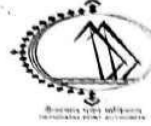

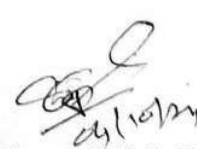
